What is interlibrary loan?

The Interlibrary Loan Service provided by the NCKU Library is a resource sharing service that allows eligible users to request items not available in the NCKU Library. It is available to eligible users on a cost-recovery basis. (more details)

- Will be delivered often within 24 hours
- Charges: NTD\$3 per page without a processing fee

II. Nationwide Document Delivery Service (NDDS)

- An online request from Taiwan
- First-time users should register first
- Fast Document Delivery Service among 7 Universities
- Charges :

(1)Domestic Borrowing:

Fees vary depending on the lending library. Most libraries charge NT\$5 per page plus a NT\$20 processing fee for copies. Fees vary depending on the lending library. Most libraries charge NT\$100 per request plus NT\$70 return postage for loans.

(2)International Borrowing:

NT\$450 per request for copies.

NT\$800 per request plus return postage for loans.

Above mentioned prices are the standard fee of most libraries for your reference only, as fee policies vary among libraries.

PRIMO AI: Research Assistant

*Use Al features to help you with your research ideas!

- Natural language conversation, which can save conversation records with AI
- Ability to follow up with more questions and view the Algebrated search query (transparent process!)
- Reduced AI hallucination direct links to original documents available
- It is a good helper at the beginning of your research, helping you find your research topics





How to use PRIMO AI

- Sign in with your Cheng-Kung Portal (成功入口) account
- Ask a question-Type your query in natural
- Al Generates answer– Summarizes key info from abstracts/descriptions– Provides in-line citations + list of sources
- Check & Explore further & Research history



The trial demonstrated the feasibility of implementing ICOPE in a fragmented resource setting, with high satisfaction reported by both 6) and providers (92–93%). Health outcomes improved in both groups after six months; however, statistically significant differences favoring the ICOPE intervention were observed in vitality (measured by the Mini-Nutritional Assessment Short Form), mobility (measured by the Short Physical Performance Battery), and psychological health (measured by the Geriatric Depression Al answers include sources with full-text access Scale five item.).

These findings suggest that the ICOPE model may offer advantages over traditional care in addressing declines in intrinsic capacity domains relevant to chronic condition management among older adults. The trial supports the acceptability and potential health benefits of integrated care approaches that focus on person-centered pathways and multidisciplinary management.

Other publications in the context discuss the adoption, adherence, and implementation challenges of ICOPE but do not provide direct comparative RCT data on chronic condition management versus traditional care models. For example, adherence studies indicate that older and more impaired individuals are more likely to discontinue ICOPE follow-up, highlighting the need for targeted strategies

IV. CORE SEARCH SKILLS — **BOOLEAN LOGIC + SEARCH SKILLS**

Simple words used as conjunctions to combine or exclude keywords (concepts) in a search, resulting in more focused



- When searching for different topics (e.g., climate change AND overheat)
- When a word or concept has numerous synonyms (e.g., happy **OR** cheerful **OR** joyful)
- excludes specific terms

IV. CORE SEARCH SKILLS – BOOLEAN LOGIC + SEARCH SKILLS

Easy Search Tips!

These tips work in most databases, but **heads-up**: in **PubMed**, if you use * or " ", it'll disable the auto-mapping of free words to its controlled terms.

- I. Use a **unified term** in the **database** to describe the same concept. (Different databases have their own unique controlled vocabulary.)
- 2. The terms are provided by experts.
- 3. It often encompasses both **broad and narrow** knowledge concepts.

Thus, you can use **one term** to **search for all** synonyms or related concepts and retrieve all relevant results!


